Applications Now Open to Undergraduate Students

The Association of Dental Groups (ADG) is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applications for the 2017 ADG Bursary Awards.

Like last year, undergraduate applicants can apply for one of two categories – either ‘Professionalism’ or ‘Skill Mix in Dentistry’.

Within those two areas, undergraduate students – including dentists, dental hygienists, dental therapists and clinical dental technicians – have a chance to win gold, silver or bronze, with bursary prizes of £1,000, £750 and £250 up for grabs.

For ‘Skill Mix in Dentistry’, applicants must submit an essay describing their experiences of how skill mix can be used effectively within their training environment and how it can be used to deliver effective dental care.

For the ‘Professionalism’ award, the applicant must cover the competencies of ethics, professionalism, scope of practice and communication.

The 2016 undergraduate ADG Bursary Awards winners were Rebecca Exley (gold), Danny James Watts (silver) and Ryan Howells (bronze) for

'Professionalism', and Awais Safdar Ali (gold), Jack Thomas Stanley (silver) and Alan Lyons (bronze) for 'Skill Mix in Dentistry'.
