Up until 31st December 2016, the Association of Dental Groups (ADG) will be taking applications for the prestigious undergraduate and postgraduate Bursary Awards.

For the postgraduate competition, postgraduate dental students – or dentists with a dental degree undertaking postgraduate or vocational / foundation training – are required to put together a project focusing on either improving access for disadvantaged patients or raising awareness about oral cancers.

Undergraduates entering the ‘Skill Mix in Dentistry’ category must submit an essay detailing the use of various skills in the dental setting, including ethics, professionalism, scope of practice and communication.

Those wishing to apply for the ‘Professionalism’ category on the other hand should describe a time and situation in which they have demonstrated professionalism and ethicality.

The Awards are an ideal opportunity for students to demonstrate their skills and earn recognition for their ideas. Plus, all winners will be presented with cash prizes.
